Description of Project:
The award winning, 22,755 square foot, 12 classroom, Jubilee Family Resource Center was developed by a partnership of the IFF, the Lawndale Christian Development Corporation and the Carole Robertson Center for Learning. Funded by the Chicago Empowerment Zone, the IFF and other public and private partners, the center serves 217 children from birth to school age in Chicago's North Lawndale community. In addition to the 12 large classrooms, each with attached toilets and a direct exit to the outdoors, this center features ample

support space, including a large indoor active play area/ community meeting space, an interior courtyard for protected toddler outdoor play, conference rooms and a full commercial kitchen. In addition to providing North Lawndale with vital child care services, the center created over 50 new jobs to the community and has spurred other community investments.
